

***** EMERGENCY ACTION MESSAGE *****
SMITH & WESSON/ WALTHER PPK & PPK/S RECALL

To all Students and Friends of CCW Academy.

This message was received from the Washoe County Sheriff's Department so that we can spread the word in regard to this important safety message.

If you own a Smith & Wesson/Walter handgun that was manufactured between March 21, 2001 and February 3, 2009 there has been an important recall issued as of February 20, 2009. Smith & Wesson has identified a condition that may exist in certain **PPK and PPK/S** pistols which **may permit a round to be discharged without the trigger being pulled. When the manual safety is disengaged**, Smith & Wesson's Product Engineering Group has determined that the possibility exists in certain firearms that lowering the hammer may cause a chambered round to fire. If you own one of these guns, **UNLOAD YOUR FIREARM, TAKE IT OUT OF SERVICE AND CONTACT SMITH & WESSON FOR MORE INFORMATION!** I have attached a list of the serial numbers below. If this is your primary DEFENSE weapon, you should take it out of service immediately.
